

Developed by wealthy landowner Hugh Locke King in 1907 Brooklands was the first purpose built motor racing circuit in the world. It has been known ever since as a world renowned centre of technology and engineering excellence and has become synonymous with major events in British aviation and motor sport history. These include:



- Construction and opening of the World's first purpose built motor racing circuit
- First powered flight in a British built airplane
- World land speed record was broken for the first time at Brooklands
- First British Grand Prix
- First flight of a Hawker Hurricane
- First flight of a Vickers VC 10
- First around the world flight by a microlite started and finished at Brooklands
